Description:

HuMed Clinical: HuMed clinical opportunities will include and be centered around HuMed shadowing. Students can choose to shadow practitioners that are on a pre-approved list, or may be able to shadow a practitioner not on the list with approval from Dr. Mendez. Practitioners on the pre-approved list include (but are not limited to) physicians (MDs and DOs), chiropractors, acupuncturists, healing touch therapists and bio-energetic therapists. Students will also have the opportunity to participate in a translational research project at the Karmanos Cancer Institute, for clinical Co-Curricular credit (substituting for 1 practitioner of the required three).
