

Our interview day is very different than many other medical school interview days. We respect your busy schedules and invite you to ask for more information if we do not automatically provide it.

Your interview will last approximately one hour beginning at the time on your individual letter. It is usually conducted by one member of the admission committee which consists of clinicians, basic scientists, administrative members, and students. Occasionally there may be two persons from the committee if one of them is new, or one is a student member. They will have had your entire application including your secondary materials to review in advance. We will not be able to provide the name of your interviewer prior to the morning of your interview as circumstances can present an unexpected change.

We will be happy to assist you in any way regarding your interview: directions, additional parking information; travel time; transportation options; activities while you are in the city; etc. You may email admissions@med.wayne.edu or call 313.577.1466.

An optional tour of the medical school which will include lunch is conducted by 1st and/or 2nd year medical students from 12 noon – approximately 1:00 p.m. Please feel free to ask the student anything you would like to know about their experiences.

If you hold a Permanent Resident Visa, please be prepared to show your card when you arrive for your interview.
