



Our interview day is very different than most medical school interviews. We respect your busy schedules and invite you to ask for more information if we do not automatically provide it.

Your interview will last approximately one hour beginning at the time on your individual letter. It is usually conducted by one member of the admissions committee which consists of clinicians, basic scientists, administrative members, and students. Occasionally there may be two persons from the committee if one of them is new, or one is a student member. They will have had your entire application including your secondary materials to review in advance. We will not be able to provide the name of your interviewer until the morning of your interview as circumstances can present an unexpected change.

A tour of the medical school which will include lunch is conducted by 1st and/or 2nd year medical students from 12 noon – 1:00 p.m.

While we do not provide a formal Financial Aid presentation, the Office of Financial Aid is located in our building and you are welcome to drop in and ask any questions pertinent to your personal circumstances.

If you will not be attending your interview and would like to withdraw your application, please send an e-mail to admissions@med.wayne.edu. Admissions committee members spend considerable time reviewing application prior to an interview, so please be courteous of their time in notifying us of any changes.

If you hold a Permanent Resident visa, please be prepared to show your card when you arrive for your interview.
