Since you are coming in from out of town, perhaps you will be looking for some place to stay while you are in Detroit. As in many cities, Detroit has many hotels, some of which are nicer and more reputable than others. Listed below are a few suggestions of places to stay in and around Detroit. Also, you will find some information on taxi and shuttle services from the airport. Metropolitan Airport is located approximately 45 minutes (rush hour) from WSU School of Medicine. At each of these hotels, this is a substantial discount off the regular room rates, but please ask them for their lowest current rate because they will occasionally offer specials which may be lower than those listed. Each of the hotels may be able to offer a complimentary shuttle service to the medical school at times, so be sure to ask.

There is a shuttle service that previous visitors have recommended, Metropolitan Shuttle bus Service. The cost for the round trip from Metropolitan Airport to the medical school will be less than a taxi. Ask for the current rate when you make a reservation. You will need to make reservations at least 24 hours in advance and ask where they are located at the airport since we have two (and soon three) terminals. Metropolitan Shuttle bus Service can be reached at (734) 727-1740.

Taxi fare from Metropolitan Airport to the medical school will run about \$40.00 - \$50.00 each way. Tell the driver you want to go to the Detroit Medical Center and the school is located on East Canfield between Brush and St. Antoine.
