program or otherwise, to participate in the Trip.

Waiver of WSU Liability for Dangers and Risks

I understand that there are certain dangers, hazards, and risks inherent in international
travel and the activities included in the Trip which could include the hazards listed in Exhibit A
and WSU cannot and does not assume responsibility for any such personal injuries or property
damage.

Responsibility for Medical Needs

There are no health-related reasons or problems which preclude or restrict my
participation in this Trip. Further, I am aware of all of my applicable personal medical needs and
have arranged for adequate hospitalization insurance to meet any and all of my needs for
payment of hospital costs while undertaking this Trip. I agree that WSU cannot be and is not
responsible for attending to any of my medical or medication needs, and I assume all risk and
responsibility therefore, and that if I am required to be hospitalized while in a foreign country or
in the United States during this Trip, WSU cannot and does not assume any legal responsibility
for payment of such costs.

Disclaimer

I understand that WSU in no way represents, or acts as agent for _____
(Host Institution), the transportation carriers, hotels, and other suppliers of services connected
with the Trip. I further understand and agree that WSU, its governing board, employees and
agents are:

- a) Not responsible or liable for any injury, damage, loss, accident,
delay or other irregularity which may be caused by the defect
of any vehicle or the negligence or default of the Host
Institution, or any company or person engaged in providing or
performing any of the services involved in the Trip;
- b) Not responsible for losses or expenses due to sickness, weather, strikes,
hostilities, wars, natural disasters, or other such causes;
- c) Not responsible for any disruption of travel arrangements, or any consequent
additional expenses that may be incurred therefrom.

Assumption of the Risk Involved

Knowing the dangers, hazards and risks of such activities, and in consideration of being permitted to participate, on behalf of my family, heirs, and personal representative(s), I agree to assume all the risks and responsibilities surrounding my participation in the Trip, the transportation, and in any independent research or activities undertaken, and in advance release, and forever discharge, release, waive, forever discharge, and covenant not to sue WSU, its governing board, officers, agents, and employees, ("Releases"), from and against any and all liability for any harm, injury, damage, claims demands, actions, cause of action, costs, and expenses of any nature whatsoever which I may have or which may hereafter accrue to me, arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury, including but not limited to suffering and death, that I may sustain or to any property belonging to me, whether caused by the negligence or carelessness of the "Releasees," or otherwise, while in, on, upon, or in transit to or from the Host country where the Academic Program is being conducted.

Potential Travel and Accommodation Problems

I acknowledge and agree to accept all responsibility for loss or additional expenses due to delays or other changes in the means of transportation, other services, or sickness, weather, strikes, or other unforeseen causes. I acknowledge and understand that WSU assumes no liability whatsoever for any loss, damage, destruction, theft or the like to my luggage or personal belongings, and that I have retained adequate insurance or have sufficient funds to replace such belongings and will hold WSU harmless therefrom.

Passport, Visa and Vaccinations

I understand that I am responsible for obtaining my own passport, visa and public health vaccinations.

Reservation of Rights

I acknowledge that WSU reserves the following rights that it may exercise in its sole discretion: (1) the right to cancel the Trip, (ii) the right to make alterations, changes, and modifications in any part of the Trip itinerary and the activities in connection therewith.

Legal Problems

I acknowledge and understand that should I have or develop legal problems with any foreign nationals or government of the host country, I will attend to the matter personally with my own personal funds. WSU is not responsible for providing any assistance under such circumstances.

Acceptable Conduct

I am aware, that as a guest in a foreign country, there is certain behavior that is unacceptable and could lead to possible disruption of my participation in the Academic Program. I assure WSU that I will act in an appropriate manner at all times.

Emergency Medical Treatment

I understand and agree that "Releasees" do not have medical personnel available at the location of the Academic Program, during transportation, at the Host Institution, or anywhere in the Foreign Country. I understand and agree that "Releasees" are granted permission to authorize emergency medical treatment, if necessary, and that such action by "Releasees" shall be subject to the terms of this Agreement. I understand and agree that "Releasees" assume no responsibility for any injury or damage which might arise out of or in connection with such authorized emergency medical treatment.

Binding Nature of Release

It is my express intent that this release and hold harmless agreement shall bind the members of my family and spouse, if I am alive, and my family, estate, heirs, administrators, personal representatives, or assigns, if I am deceased, and shall be deemed as a "Releasee," Waiver, Discharge, and Covenant not to sue the above-named "Releasees." I agree to save and hold harmless, indemnify, and defend "Releasees" from any claim by my family, arising out of my participation in the Academic Program.

Representations

In signing this Release, I acknowledge and represent that I have become fully informed of the content of this waiver of liability and hold harmless agreement by reading it before signing it, and by signing this document as my own free act and deed confirm that no oral representations, statements, or inducements, apart from the foregoing written statement, have been made.
