DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD
Roberto Romero, M.D.

Roberto Romero, M.D., is an Obstetrician and Gynecologist with a sub-specialty in Maternal-Fetal Medicine. Originally from Venezuela, Dr. Romero spent 16 years at Yale University, during which he completed his residency in Obstetrics and Gynecology, and subspecialty training in Maternal-Fetal Medicine. He also completed specialized training in Gynecologic Oncology, the physiology of the uterine cervix during pregnancy, and five years in Immunobiology. He later joined the faculty at Yale University and was appointed the Director of Perinatal Research.

In 1992, Dr. Romero became Professor and Vice Chair of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Wayne State University/Detroit Medical Center and Chief of the Perinatology Research Branch of the *Eunice Kennedy Shriver* National Institute of Child Health and Human Development of the National Institutes of Health.

Since the establishment of the Perinatology Research Branch at the WSU School of Medicine, Dr. Romero has served as Chief of the Branch. He is also a Professor of Molecular Obstetrics and Genetics at Wayne State University, and an attending physician at the Detroit Medical Center.

Under Dr. Romero's leadership, scientific discoveries and life-saving medical breakthroughs to the problems of fetal and infant morbidity and mortality are made on an ongoing basis. Focusing on the mechanisms responsible for the onset of labor and fetal injury, PRB physicians and scientists have made many pioneering contributions to decrease adverse pregnancy outcomes. Dr. Romero leads an international team and has attracted talented physicians from the United States and around the world. He is amongst the most active, influential and respected perinatal investigators in the world and brings major academic visibility and respect to our University.

As author of more than 700 peer-reviewed publications and several books, including a medical best seller (*Prenatal Diagnosis of Congenital Anomalies*), Dr. Romero is the recipient of countless awards and recognitions from his peers. Most recently, a discovery that found that genetics play a significant role in some preterm births was recognized in February by the March of Dimes with its prestigious award for Best Research in Prematurity.

Dr. Romero is widely regarded as one of the most prominent intellectual leaders in modern obstetrics. He is a member of the Institute of Medicine of the National Academies, one of the greatest honors bestowed by the scientific community upon one of its members. He has received multiple Doctorate Honoris Causa from universities throughout the world. The Semmelweis University in Budapest, Hungary bestowed the highest honor a university can award and predicted that Dr. Romero's discoveries of the role of infection in the human fetus will change medicine in the 21st century.

COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER & CANDIDATE FOR HONORARY DEGREE
Regina M. Benjamin, M.D., M.B.A.
Doctor of Science

Regina M. Benjamin, MD, MBA is the 18th Surgeon General of the United States Public Health Service. As America's Doctor, she provides the public with the best scientific information available on how to improve their health and the health of the nation. Dr. Benjamin also oversees the operational command of 6,500 uniformed health officers who serve in locations around the world to promote, protect, and advance the health of the American People.

Dr. Benjamin is Founder and Former CEO of the Bayou La Batre Rural Health Clinic in Alabama, former Associate Dean for Rural Health at the University of South Alabama College of Medicine in Mobile, and immediate Past Chair of the Federation of State Medical Boards of the United States. In 1995, she was the first physician under age 40 and the first African-American woman to be elected to the American Medical Association Board of Trustees. She served as President of the American Medical Association Education and Research Foundation and Chair of the AMA Council on Ethical and Judicial Affairs (CEJA). In 2002 she became President of the Medical Association State of Alabama, making her the first African-American female president of a State Medical Society in the United States.

Dr. Benjamin has a BS in chemistry from Xavier University, New Orleans; MD degree from the University of Alabama, Birmingham; an MBA from Tulane University and 5 Honorary Doctorates. She attended Morehouse School of Medicine and completed her family medicine residency in Macon, Ga. She established a clinic in a small fishing village in Alabama to help its uninsured residents. Dr. Benjamin persevered through Hurricane Georges in 1998, Hurricane Katrina in 2005, and a devastating fire, in 2006, often putting up her own money to cover expenses. She also became nationally prominent for her business acumen and humane approach to preventive medicine.

Dr. Benjamin is a member of the National Academy of Science's Institute of Medicine, and a Fellow of the American Academy of Family Physicians. She was a Kellogg National Fellow and a Rockefeller Next Generation Leader. Some of her numerous board memberships include the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, the Kaiser Commission on Medicaid and the Uninsured, the Catholic Health Association, and Morehouse School of Medicine.

In 1998 Dr Benjamin was the United States recipient of the Nelson Mandela Award for Health and Human Rights. She was named by *Time Magazine* as one of the "Nation's 50 Future Leaders Under Age 40 and Under." She was featured in a *New York Times* article, "Angel in a White Coat," "Person of the Week" on ABC's *World News Tonight* with Peter Jennings, "Woman of the Year" by CBS *This Morning*, and in *People Magazine*. She was featured on the December 1999 cover of *Clarity Magazine*, received the 2000 National Caring Award which was inspired by Mother Teresa, was on the January 2003 cover of *Reader's Digest*, received the papal honor *Pro Ecclesia et Pontifice* from Pope Benedict XVI and was awarded a MacArthur Genius Award Fellowship.
