The Minority Physician Recruitment Program (MRP) works closely with all Boston University Medical Center training programs and other departments to increase the proportion of under-represented minority (URM) residents, fellows and faculty in order to achieve excellence and better serve our diverse patient population. We strive to achieve these goals by focusing on three areas:

Education & Training

The Subsidized Elective Program, sponsored by the Minority Recruitment Program allows qualified 4th year medical students that are considering applying to one of our residency programs the opportunity to have their housing, travel, and living costs subsidized during the visiting elective. The URM Mentorship Program is a structured program supported by the Minority Physician Recruitment Program (MRP) and the BUSM Office of Diversity and Multicultural Affairs.
