

The University of Michigan O'Brien Kidney Research Core Center has been funded to hold an 8 week research experience for medical students that will begin this June. This program allows medical students to conduct research under the direction of an established scientist in the areas of basic, systems biological, translational or clinical research in kidney disease. The program provides a weekly stipend of \$415 per week for the 8 weeks, plus registration in the international conference, Systems Biology of Kidney Disease.
