

To the Class of 2022:


I would like to be among the first to say upon this auspicious occasion: Congratulations, doctors.

COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

Rana Awdish, M.S., M.D. '02, FACP, FCCP

Dr. Rana Awdish is the author of "In Shock: My Journey from Death to Recovery and the Redemptive Power of Hope," a critically acclaimed, bestselling memoir based on her own critical illness. She is a sought-after public speaker, delivering inspirational keynote addresses to groups ranging from professional medical societies, to members of Congress, to organizations combating homelessness.

A pulmonary and critical care physician, she serves as the director of the Pulmonary Hypertension Program at Henry Ford Hospital. She also serves as medical director of Care Experience for the System, where she has integrated compassionate communication strategies and Narrative Medicine practice into the curriculum.

Dr. Awdish received the Schwartz Center's National Compassionate Caregiver of the Year Award in 2017. She was named Physician of the Year by Press Ganey in 2017 for her work on improving communication and received the Critical Care Teaching Award in 2016. She has been inducted into the Alpha Omega Alpha medical honor society and the Gold Humanism Honor Society.

Her narrative non-fiction essays have been published in The Examined Life Journal, Intima, CHEST and The New England Journal of Medicine. She has written editorials for The Harvard Business Review, Annals of Internal Medicine, The Washington Post and The Detroit Free Press. Her essay, "The Shape of the Shore," was awarded a Sydney by The New York Times and was nominated for a Pushcart Prize.

Before joining Henry Ford, Dr. Awdish completed her training at Mount Sinai Beth Israel in Manhattan. She attended Wayne State University Medical School and completed her undergraduate degree at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor. She is board certified in Internal Medicine, Pulmonary and Critical Care Medicine.

INVESTITURE OF DOCTORAL HOODS

One of the most colorful features of an academic regalia procession is the appearance of the graduates, faculty, cabinet and Board of Governors in full academic regalia. These caps, gowns and hoods have long histories and their patterns and colors have special significance.

The gown recalls the time when all students in centers of higher learning were members of the clergy and therefore wore garments the church considered proper.

The Oxford or "mortarboard" cap worn today is thought to be a combination of the close-fitting cap worn indoors by scholars of the Middle Ages and the soft square biretta worn outdoors. The tuft on the early cap has been replaced by a colored tassel that signifies the college granting the degree.

In modern universities, the distinctive mark of a degree is a hood, which in its earliest form was simply an article of clothing. Since the churches and lecture halls of European universities were cold, drafty places, scholars wore hoods as head coverings, attached to a cape or worn separately.

American universities, unlike those of England and Europe, have adopted a standard code of academic regalia. The design of the gown, the color of the tassel and the pattern, length and colors of the hood all have special meaning.

Each graduate wears a gown appropriate to the degree granted. The doctor's gown is faced with velvet and has bell-shaped sleeves. Each sleeve carries three bars of velvet, or chevrons.

The most colorful part of the costume is the hood. The color of the velvet trim indicates the department in which the degree was granted; the width corresponds to the level of the degree. At this ceremony, candidates for medical doctoral degrees wear hoods with green velvet running along a black background, representing the academic color of medicine and the yellow and green silk representing Wayne State University.

OATH OF COMMITMENT CLASS OF 2022

To give to my teachers the respect and gratitude which is their due; to regard my colleagues equally with my brethren; and to teach this art by precept, by lecture, and by every other mode of instruction, to those who practice the healing arts.

As a physician, I will maintain the ultimate dignity of life while guiding its arrival, protecting its course, and easing its natural passage from this world; I will offer to those who seek my aid not only my knowledge and skills, but my warmth and compassion as well; whatever in the lives of those I shall see or hear, either in my practice or outside of my practice, which should not be made public, this will I hold in silence, believing that such things should not be spoken.

I will conduct myself with honesty and virtue; with conscience and dignity will I live my life and practice my art. In all circumstances, I will consider every individual as equal without regard to race, creed, or gender, refusing no one my help. I will abstain from every act of injustice and corruption. Above all else, I will do no harm (Primum Non Nocere).

I freely take this oath and will maintain the noble traditions of my profession, always tempering my science with the warmth and humility of the true physician.


