- Ms. Cassin is a nationally recognized healthcare executive and turnaround specialist for 30 years.
- As CEO of Hospice of Southeastern Michigan, she retired their debt within 2 years and maintained profitability throughout her tenure, growing the company over 10 years to over \$50 million in revenues and 1,000 employees. This earned Hospice of Michigan the "Best Managed Non-Profit" award by Crain's Detroit. She has served as the President of the National Hospice and Palliative Care Organization and on its Board.
- Ms. Cassin has received numerous national awards from the first National Hospice Organization's "Heart of Hospice Award", to the Founders Award from that same organization. She was named a "Woman to Watch" in 2009, and "The 100 Most Influential Women in Michigan" in 2016 by Crain's Detroit Magazine.
